


Hindmarsh Island Fun-Fly

Information Package

Steve and Gerri Johnson's property on Hindmarsh Island is an ideal spot to fly aeroplanes, both full-size and models. Steve has kindly invited Holdfast Club members and their families to enjoy a weekend of flying and social enjoyment on 21-22 May. You are welcome to camp onsite or find accommodation in nearby Goolwa if you prefer. You may choose to spend the full weekend flying, or visit for just one day on either Saturday or Sunday. Both wheeled and float planes can be flown, so bring whichever you choose.

How to get there

Make your way to Goolwa, then cross the bridge to Hindmarsh Island and stay on Randell Rd for approximately 9.5 km until you reach the turn-off into Pullen Rd on your left.



Proceed to the end of Pullen Rd where you will see a sign directing you to enter the double gate into the property. Follow the track between the two fences until you get to another set of double gates on your right which lead you onto one of the grass runways. Head towards the windsock and turn left. You have reached your destination.




ENTRANCE TO HINDMARSH ISLAND FUN-FLY

Assigned Areas

Below you will see the areas assigned for parking, camping and flying.

What to Bring

If you plan on camping on site, you need to bring your own camping equipment.

You must supply your own food and drinks, Esky, ice, picnic tables & chairs, etc as required.

Pilots should bring fuel/batteries, chargers, tools appropriate for the models being flown. Mains power is available.

Please DO NOT post photos of the property on social media.

You enter the property at your own risk.

Stay alert for approaching full-size aircraft.

No alcohol consumption while participating in flying activity.

There will be a bonfire night on Saturday.

A dinghy and kayaks will be available for float plane retrieval.
